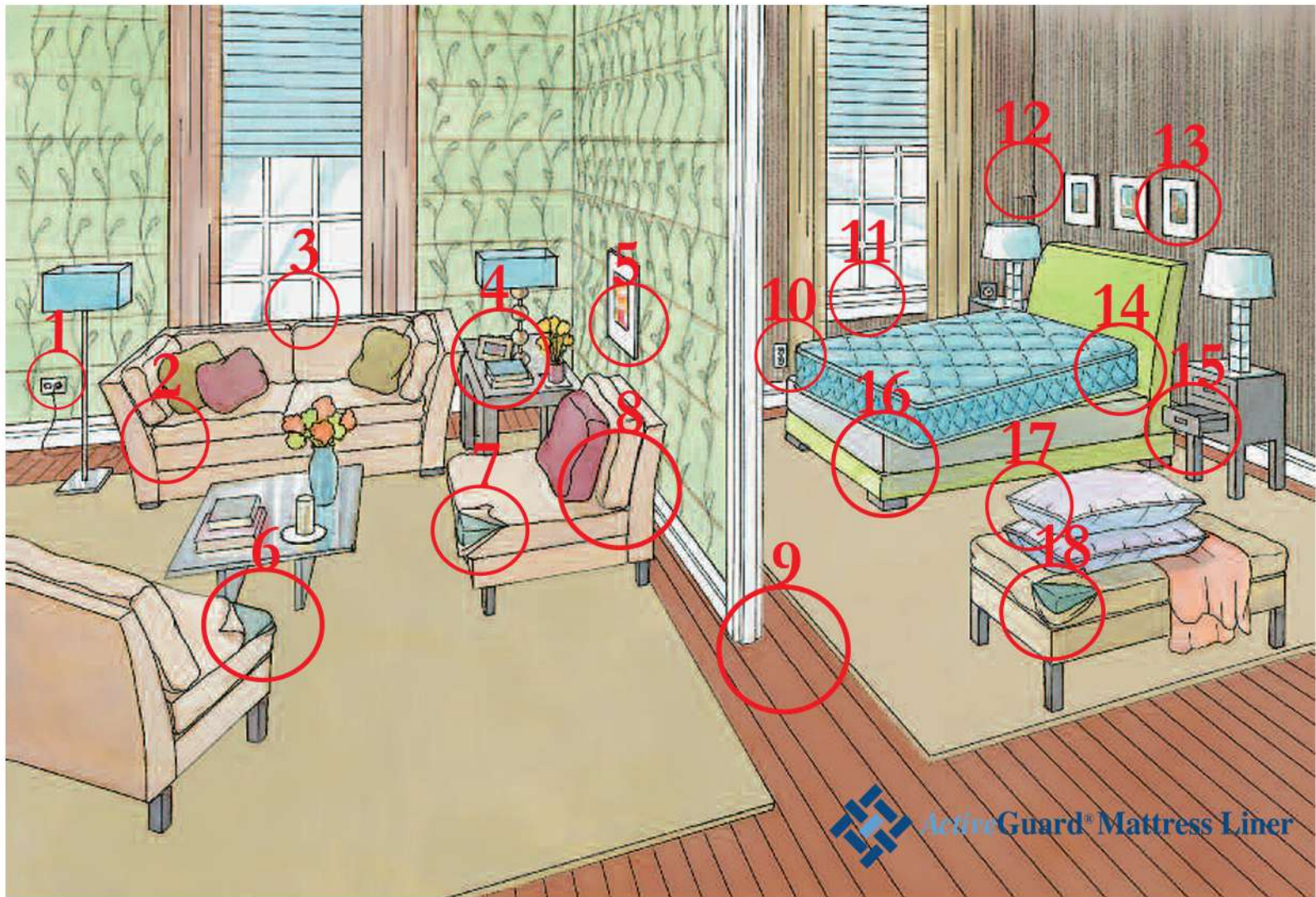


Inspecting for Bed Bugs (Check-off the following areas)

- 1. 10. Face plates of electrical outlets and light switches; including the area around the electrical box of each
- 2. 8. Remove and check zippers, seams and tufts under and in between cushions of upholstered furniture
- 3. 11. Cracks and crevices of furniture, windows and door frames
- 4. Under loose items such as books, magazines and other items near or on furniture
- 5. 13. Paintings, posters, pictures and mirrors; pay special attention to nail and screw hole attachment sites to the walls
- 6. 7. 18. Rips and tears in upholstered furniture
- 9. Pull back carpeting to expose padding, tacks strips, non-skid mats and baseboards
- 12. Cracks in plaster and peeling wallpaper
- 14. Bed frame and headboards
- 15. Furniture drawers, including inside, top, bottom, joints, sliding tracks and screw holes
- 16. Mattresses and box springs; top and bottom seams, tufts, cords, handles and any rips or tears - MUST remove fabric underneath box spring to examine void
- 17. Bedroom throw pillows (tufts, seams and zippers)

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
